C is the passing grade.

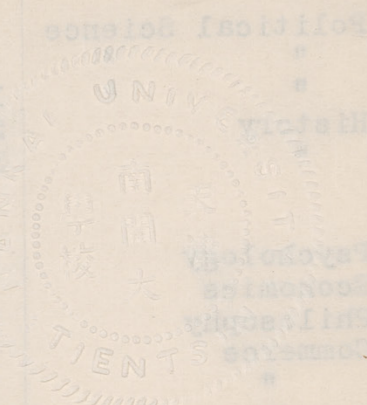

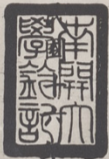

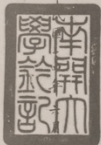
