- 1.—Nos. 4 and 7, in the Afternoon Programme, open only to McGill Undergraduates.
- 2.—All other events, open to Students (properly accredited) of recognized Universities.
- 3.—Entries must be made before 1 P.M. on Wednesday, October 24th, to any Member of the Committee.
- 4.—A bell will be rung three minutes before each event, when Competitors must at once proceed to the starting point. Each heat will be started punctually.
- 5.—All above events open *only* to Amateurs.
- 6.—The decision of the Judges in all cases to be final.
- 7.—The Committee to be judges of eligibility of all Competitors.
- 8.—Only Club officials, the Press, and Competitors in uniform allowed inside the railing.
- 9.—No weights allowed in Nos. 2, 4 and 6.
- 10.—Second prizes will be withdrawn unless there are three *bona fide* competitors.
