## McGill Interscholastic Track Meet

To Be Held At

The Percival Molson Memorial Stadium

### PRELIMINARIES:

Junior Class III.—High Jump (Trials),

Senior—Shot Put (Trials), Pole Vault Trials),

Broad Jump (Trials), High Jump (Trials).

### Entries:

ENTRIES CLOSE AT TWELVE O'CLOCK ON SATURDAY, MAY 21ST, WITH MR. J. L. O'BRIEN, MANAGER, MCGILL TRACK CLUB, MOLSON HALL, MCGILL UNIVERSITY.

An entrance fee of twenty-five cents (25c.) per event will accompany all entries. One dollar (\$1.00) per relay team.

Boys will hand entries to School representatives, who will send them in, and entries will only be received from the School representative.

### Prizes:

Medals will be given for first, and Ribbons for second and third in individual events. Ribbons will be given to the individuals and a Shield to the winning team in the relay races.

**Championship Cup:** A handsome Challenge Cup has been donated by Mr. A. P. S. Glassco, to be held for one year by the School gaining the highest number of points, including the relay race (for which the winning team gets five points.) First place in individual events counts five points; second place three points third place one point. In the event of a tie, the one of the tied teams which secures the higher place in the relay race shall be declared the winner of the Championship.

### Conditions:

All competitors must be amateurs, and entries must be accompanied by the correct fee and properly certified, otherwise they will be rejected.

Competitors will weigh in running costume at 9.30 a.m. for the preliminaries, and at 1.00 p.m. for the finals, at the Stadium on the day of the Meet. Competitors must be accompanied at the weighing by some duly authorized person representing the School. The age requirements as stated on the entry blank mean that a boy must be under the required age on the day of the Meet, May 28th, 1921.

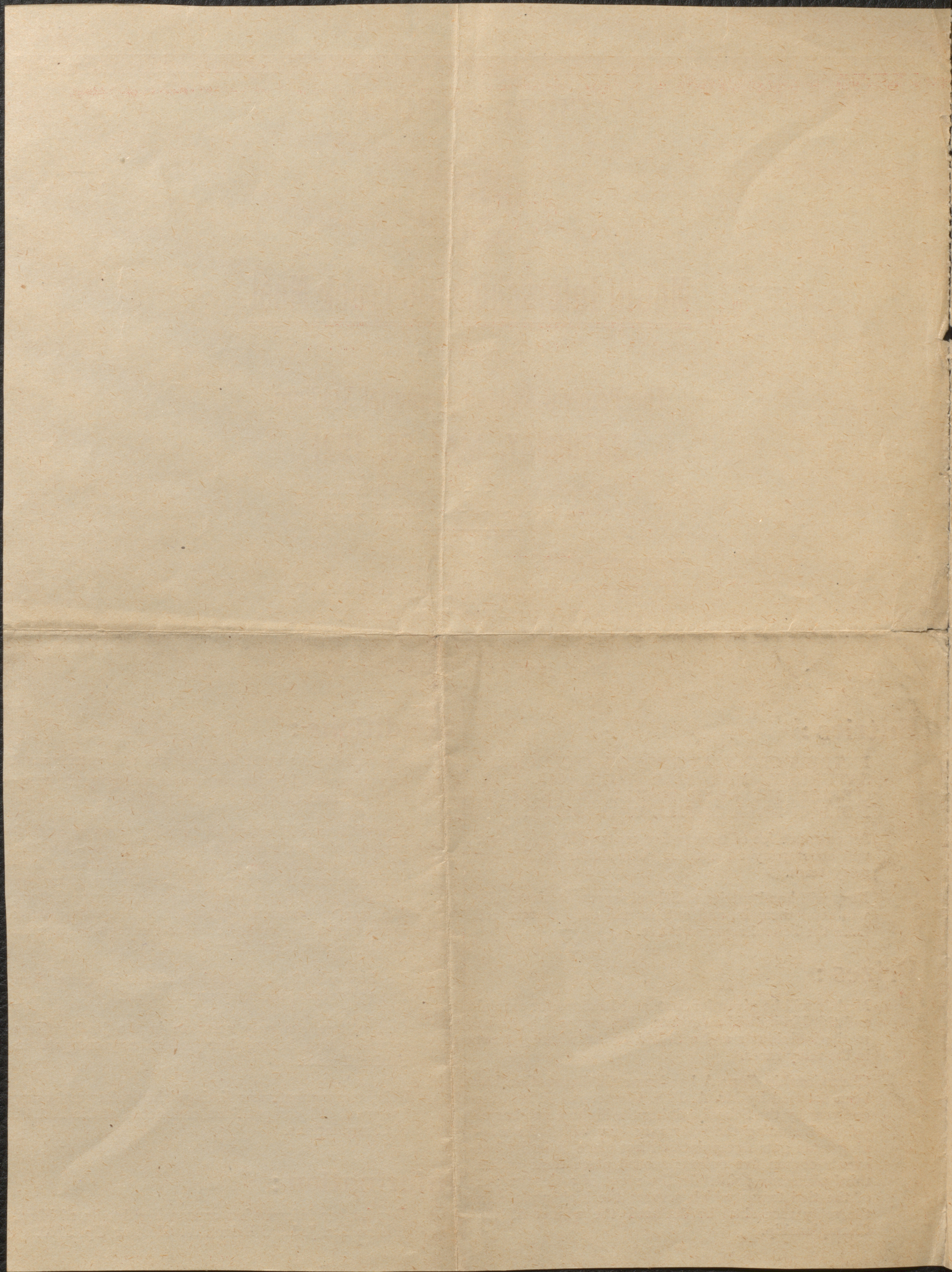
No boy will be permitted to enter in more than five (5) events; the relay not to count.

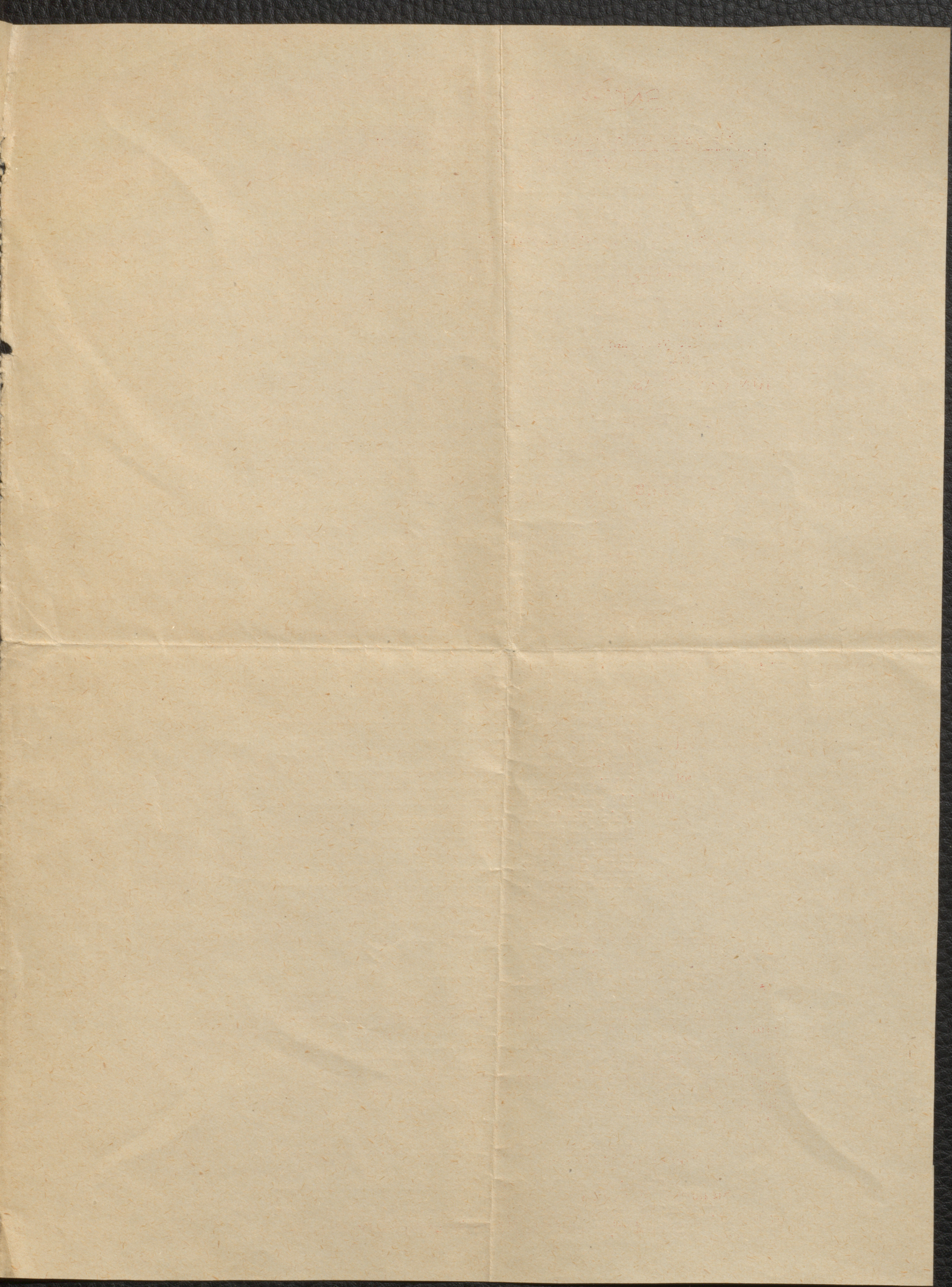
Competitors can only compete in the Junior Class to which they belong, but Juniors may compete in Senior Events.
