**SPACE PROBE:** With a new space research tool, a 16-inch former naval gun, a team from McGill University in Montreal, Canada, is carrying out a high-altitude probing project on the coast of Barbados in the West Indies. After firing test shots with dummy slugs from the former United States Navy gun, the team shot a series of special space projectiles

70 miles into space. The Martlet projectiles, designed at McGill, are intended to carry data-gathering instruments. Members of McGill's High Altitude Research Project stood beside the 142-ton gun, modified to carry the space projectile. The project has the support of the United States Army Research Office.
