The English and the Irish, it is said, are the most beautiful people in the world.

I hope we are doing good work in Vienna. Dr. Munnro will have written to you how he is finding his way. He is doing excellent work, is doing the whole day, knows how are the people ~~that~~ wants to explore for their progress and is a keen on his work as any good English sportsman! Our communities for "International Christian Action" has the advantage of the cooperation of the whole British population, of some of the American men here, and the assistance of the international Red Cross Committee of Geneva have joined us, so that they will put in our hands every thing which will be brought together in this regard for the hospitals in this country. I got ~~the~~ the duty meeting society, the Green Hunter and some other authorities in England to start an action ~~with~~ ^{there} and it seems they are doing good work already.
