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Dear Prof Butler

There is a distinct improvement here thanks to the American and British relief. But Bucharest is in a terrible state. I went there a month ago the 180000 people were reduced to using paper dressings. They had no General anaesthetics or medicines or food. Now they have not even food. The Roumanians came in like the plague of locusts. In June in Buch. the day they arrived a Tuesday on the Friday following very few of the hospitals had any bread only vegetables. In Buch. 500 tons of milk were sent out from Vienna under escort. There is plenty of food in the land they have had the very best harvest for many years but there is no transport. - Dennis has made a list of things.
