Dear Sir,

In Sir William Osler's absence for a few days, I am sending on to you immediately a copy of the reply Sir William has received from Lord Robert Cecil, to whom he wrote on receipt of your telegram in regard to the food situation.

..."I have been making enquiries, and am told by the Home Office that if Professor Wenkebach applies to the British Military authorities at Vienna (where I understand he now is) for a visa, he should have no difficulty about coming over here, as he is a Dutchman. If any difficulty should arise, I hope you will let me know, because I think it would be very desirable for Wenkebach to come over to this country."

I have also wired this information to-day to the Secretary of the "Save the Children Fund", who had been making enquiries.
