Dear Sir,

In Sir William Osler's absence for a few days, I am sending on to you immediately a copy of the reply Sir William has received from Lord Robert Cecil, to whom he wrote on receipt of your telegram in regard to the food situation.

**. "I have been making enquiries, and am told by the Home Office that if Professor Wenkebach applies to the British Military authorities at Vienna (where I understand he now is) for a visa, he should have no difficulty about coming over here, as he is a Dutchman. If any difficulty should arise, I hope you will let me know, because I think it would be very desirable for Wenkebach to come over to this country."

I have also wired this information to-day to the Secretary of the "Save the Shildren Fund", who had been making enquiries.
