I forgot whether I wrote about the Vesal Tabulae sex at the San Marco - I think I did. Splendid as illustrating the evolution of his knowledge - also of Calcar as they are very crude in comparison with the 1543. Nothing much in Pavia - nothing in comparison with Bologna and Padua. Library good - no Vesal items of moment, not even the 1543. A.1. ed of Mundinus, but no plates. I have not been able to locate a single Mundinus MS. - I wonder where they can be. The Ambrosiana here is a fine collection. I had 5 original MSS. of Cardan to look over - the autobiography is complete - he wrote a wonderful hand - no wonder the printers liked to get his copy. Hopli here has no large stock - tho' the best publisher in Italy. Love to the bairns & Kate
