Dear Harvey

Norman joined us here last night and said you were expected back at your own place. It makes me fear our letters may have missed you - but then they will be sent back to you - I cannot repeat exactly all I have said before of the comfort you have been - the knowledge that you were with Revere is a comfort beyond anything. Everyone has been so kind, so thoughtful & helpful - I feel more thankful as the days go on - I am getting in touch with some of the men from the Battery - The Sergt is at Netley and Mrs. Emmons is looking after him - I shall probably go once to see him - All the officers have written and evidently Revere had made many friends. We came here because we had promised Revere to do so & we needed the change badly - We go back on the 20th I think - We have the little Max Muller boys here and they are devoted to Sir William.
