Still in bed - no fever, gen. condition good but I have a rousing paroxysm once a day, & a good deal of short-coughing in intervals. Practically nothing in lungs. Pfeiffers bacilli turned up the other day in the sputum so I suppose it is one of the protracted types of bronchial influenza. Very aggravating - but I am really very comfortable. So nice to hear of you all the other day from Kates letter. How I wish we could see the children.
