Your nice letter by the St Louis came Monday afternoon And many others. A nice one from Elsie about the wedding and your Return. I think you must have been pleased with the home Welcome you had - Wednesday - yesterday, I had to go to town - & ordered a thin dress at Henry black muslin with white spots an old timer - Then down far in the City to order the long talked of safe and back to lunch at the Automobile Club with Willie & Dr J. W White of Philadelphia who said Bob & Martha Came on the St Louis with him - I left them on their way to the American Embassy - Bob had telephoned here And finally caught Willie in town. I Came back at 4.45 with a Surgical Examiner And his wife who Are staying here. I think Bob & W O had a long talk about the Hospital & then Willie went to the War Office And arranged Matters. Dr White goes to Neuilly with the Penn University Hospital lot. I enclose Marians letter which is very appreciative. Bob & Hamilton lunched here Tuesday - Bateman's sister has arrived. Is tall and gawkie - I havent had time to speak to her yet but I daresay She will do all right. I like the little Chaufffeur very much. We had our first letter from Revere yesterday - such a Charming letter, I must Copy & send it. Col Birkett has written nicely about him. No address on the letter - near the sea somewhere. I have had the blues about the war for several days. I feel perfectly hopeless about Everything - Everything seems at such a stand still but it may be all right... Willie answered a pessimistic letter the other day in the paper And has so many nice notes about it. The letter from Mr Burroughs (of Hertford Col [lege?]) came out when you were here - the 1st one - Adele telephoned today to ask if they Could come Sunday for advice - I am so sorry we cant have them - all beds taken & W.O going to Cliveden probably -

Friday 4 P M I am just hurrying this off to Catch the post - Love to Canton - I havent time to write there -
