[Oxford] Tuesday 24th [Aug., 1915]

Dear Sister

I love having extras from you I found one when we came from Burley at noon yesterday and another came in the evening. Goodness knows what will happen next - so I'll send an extra by the Wednesday boat - probably my last Fridays will go by that . I am sending a picture of our Gwyn boys - They are so good looking I am sure you will like to see them. You can send them back if you do not care for them permanently. Your last was from Elsie - hope you paid a nice visit - I did not know Lady Speyle went over with you. I am hoping to hear it is all right about the Bowditch land for John & Margaret. It sounds a perfect arrangement & I hope nothing happens to prevent. I'll send a list of things later - This is only a line. We had a delightful time at Archie's except for the patheticness of the patients - most of the men suffering from shock & one from the effects of morphia having a terrible shoulder. Archie was delightful as Host in this huge place. We motored each way & enjoyed it. We are spending tonight at Lady Wantage to meet the Archbishop of York. It is diverting for W.O but I love my own bed. Bestest love
