I have written a letter which you can Make use of - I do not think it better go into the paper - because later you might have to appeal - but if you can raise some Money without too much trouble it will be a blessing - I have had several requests And I am in despair of starting at it again without Wanda - although in a way she was rather bustling to Suit Me. I leave it to you - just to do what you think best I have written M^r Henry Higginson.

We are shocked to See about Ezra Thayer in the Transcript - It will nearly Kill Billie Thayer. And he has so much to bear with Susans delicate health. I send you a letter from Hallie Which I have been trying for days to get off - Isn't it dreadful? I hope Harold Ponsonby has found himself And will keep straight. Please send the letter to Sallie because she is so interested & tell her to destroy it. We are quite Cheered up by the present work in France. Revere & Campbell had their leave stopped And are very busy - The oldest Jefferson boy is Killed - Raleigh Parkin home from the Dardanelles with dysentery. Those are all my horrors for today -
