Dearest Sister

I believe this is your birthday - Love and kisses - I am simply horrified this morning at the thought of the letter I posted last evening - and am sending this off to tell you to do nothing about Sue unless you feel it is absolutely right Your judgment is much better than mine - I should not think it right for her to live here[e] permanently - for many reasons - I am sorry I wrote the letter - fearing it may cause you worry & anxiety - so destroy it and say no if you feel it unwise. I shall understand.
