It was really splendid and has been the only cheerful thing about our Christmas. Sir William has not been very well and we naturally are not feeling very gay with Revere between the somme and the Ancre. We are all hoping for a happier 1917. I wish we could see you once more - it seems like the dark ages since the happy days, but it is a privilege to live among these wonderful people, so calm and determined.
