Dear Sir:-

We beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of May 17th enclosing bills from Butler & Tanner for which we will send a draft and charge to your account. The duty on the last shipment which contained 800 copies is in proportion to that paid on the other shipments. For example on the first 1000 we paid \$155.00; on the 200 copies we paid \$30.50 and on the 800 we paid \$126.25 so that the last 1000 though received in separate shipments the duty was but \$1.75 more while the total expenses of the last two shipments amounted to \$4.15 less than the first lot.

I regret to hear that nothing can be done with the "Oslerisms" until next January as I understood that this was practically in shape for us to put in type.

We will send a copy of Chittenden's book on Nutrition to the Governor-General of Canada with your card.
