My dear Dr. Osler,

Medici which you bought in London. I have no doubt that your
copy belonged to Coleridge. In addition to the Religio I
possess, with notes by Coleridge, I have a copy of the Vulgar
Errors with marginal notes and the initials S.T.C. The marginal
notes in both books are in ink. The Vulgar Errors has on titlepage the autograph of C. Lamb bought for S. T. Coleridge, and then
in Coleridge's writing given by S.T.C. to S. Hutchinson, sister
of Wordsworth's wife. I cannot tell you the very following(?)
remarks in these two volumes. Jack showed them to you when you
were here. I should be so pleased to see your copy so bring it
with you and we can compare notes. I hope you will stay here
a few days with me if only to see the Rylands Library.
