In the MS volume Amariah Brigham's Journals occurs the following note:- Journals of Amariah Brigham (1798-1848) during the years 1828-29 in Europe Hunt in Gross' American Medical Biography, p. 525, sayse"He left in this voyage, July 16, 1828, then in his thirtieth year. He made a daily record of his observations, indeed of whatever especially attracted his notice, which formed five folior volumestinemanuscript".
