For 1898 you will see D.D.D. (Aberdeen) D.D.D. (Edin) & F.R.S.

∴ only the D.C.D. is lacking. Now *Who's Who* (1919) gives only 2 D.C.D.'s

Durham & Trin Coll. (Toronto) & this latter is of 1902.

∴ Durham is the D.C.D. for 1898 — Lady C. does not remember exactly what year — a card to Durham would prove this.

*Who's Who* (1919) in addition to the list overleaf gives
