When the Church of St. Mary Magdalen, in Johnson's old pastorate(?) was re-planned in (?), Osler was one of the subscribers and paid for the erection of one of four piers for which the architect had planned; and on the second pier from the East end on the South side of the church in the wall between the porch and the nave occurs the inscription: "W. A. Johnson pier. Donor Dr. W. Osler."
