Dear Dr. Cushing:

Replying to your letter of July 13th, it seems strange that the Press did not advise you about the India paper edition of the Osler Biography.

As a matter of fact, we understand that only one hundred copies were printed, fifty of which were sent to us. They have now all been sold with the exception of two copies, which I am sending you today.

I quite agree with you that the drawing of Osler which appeared in our recent advertisements is very bad, and have instructed our advertising department not to use it anymore. The trouble was that the halftone illustration was little better than a black smudge, when printed on newspaper stock. We should like very much to use Sargent's "black and white" of Osler for this purpose, and if you will lend us your copy, or send us a photograph of it, we shall much appreciate it.

A copy of the Biography has been forwarded to Professor George S. Hutchinson, 137 East 66 Street, New York, with your compliments, as you requested.
