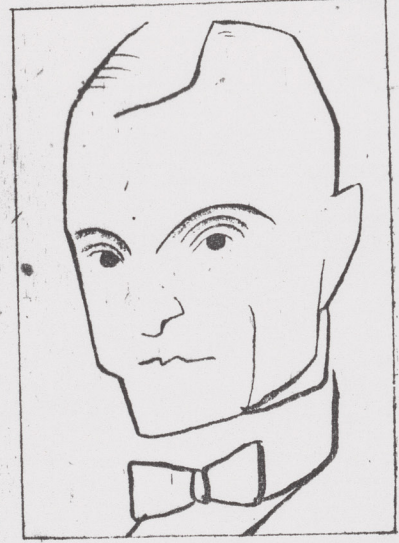

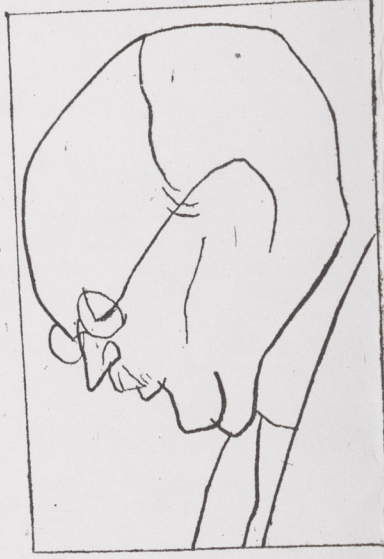
Sinclair Lewis, whose "Arrowsmith" was awarded the 1925 prize for fiction, which he refused to accept



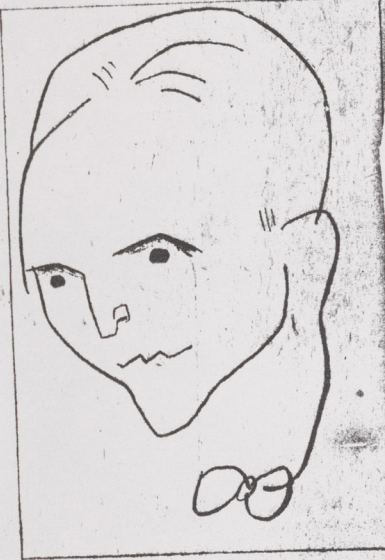
Amy Lowell, who won the posthumous award for poetry for her "What's O'Clock," her last collection of verse
