We notice that reference is made in the London Lancet of August 2nd, to some observations published last autumn in the "Transactions of the Canada Medical Association," by Professor William Osler, M.D., of McGill University, in reference to the condition of the bones and marrow in Pernicious Anaemia, as well as to other remarks on the same subject, more recently published. The latter we have not seen, but the Lancet does not accredit the source from whence it has obtained the information. This is to be regretted, as it is due to the author, as well as to the readers of the Lancet, to give them the opportunity of seeing the entire article, and not a mere abstract of observations which are of practical importance, and which are attracting very general attention. Dr. Osler has devoted a large amount of time to these inquiries, and so far as he had gone his deductions are highly interesting and instructive, and reflect credit on his persevering industry.
