I could not help feeling worried about that horrid carbuncle though I felt you were in the best of hands for treatment and nursing at Dr. Howard's. being vaccinated while that was going on must have been very sickening; you will need some good attention and I hope will prescribe the very best of everything for your dear self so there may be no repetition of these evil things if you were able to leave as intended on Thursday we shall look for a note tomorrow and hope to hear that you are much better--would not preparation of ^Wgeth's beef, iron and wine, be good for you to take and no trouble if you kept it at hand you know that or good beef tea would be good for others and if you indulge in boils you ought also to take the remedies required to heal them. I dare say you have heard from M or J all about Gertie's wedding--it went off very well notwithstanding the unpleasant weather--the wedding-gifts were gorgeous (75 or more of them) she has been the home pet for so long that there will be a blank in the house for some time though there are still the two left both pretty good curates for the parish and home work. BB is expected back tomorrow, probably Hal with him. Annie and Ed. on Saturday and then on Monday Amy and Clara.

We have Amy and Trevor with us for a few weeks T's wrist is better the swelling almost gone so it does not seem needful to do anything more with it than keep it quiet. Nellie takes them over to the Island as often as she can it seems to do them good. Chattie has one of her bad colds, the Whately children are to return home tomorrow and Father and I may go up there towards the end of the week for two or three days, but I'm changing servants again which does not agree with running about from home. Father is much the same, Aunt very well. We all send our best love and will be so glad to hear that you are all right.
