



He also wrote me when I sent the second edition to him & also the third... we discussed many of the changes in it when I saw him in 1915 in England.

We went together to the hospital at Chudston & he advised me about getting in to some special work. but I shortly afterwards got my commission & had to go overseas I sent.

The last time I saw him was in connection with the West Hospital at Hampstead. I had been examining a number of S.H.H. cases & he got the tables of exercises I was using at Heathon Park & had them tried out there on the cases sent

The last letter I had was 'an Enquiry for the names of all the physiccians I knew who had also been distinguished in Ark and I sent him a copy of Abraham Bartholin's life of

William Rimmer of Boston a real genius to whom recognition

Came too late - I think it arrived after the onset of his last illness for he did not acknowledge it and of course he never failed to do that. My letter is probably among his correspondence.

There are so many incidents and reminiscences... the visits that were all too rare... I can add to the picture of your own dear old days... with all your work & in the first place...

It was the first opportunity that I had of to start a copy of... I was so often on all the other... I had much correspondence from time to time and when he used the first edition of your book 'Exercise in Breathing'...
