Dear Dr. Sa'eed,

I sent the photograph to-day and have ordered the book.

I had a note this morning from Mr. Funk with the estimates ~~and~~ repairs at £100 and £300 to provide an income of £15 a year for a caretaker. This amount I am sure we could raise. Would it be possible to have it done under the auspices of the Regent or of the Shah, so that we could put at the head of the circular "Under the auspices of His etc. etc." I am writing to Funk and to Nelligan at once, asking them as to the names of men in Persia who should go on the Committee. In this country we would ask the President of the College of Physicians, the College of Surgeons, The Royal Society of Medicine, Dr. Cowley, Professor Margoliouth, the two Regius Professors of Medicine at Oxford and Cambridge, and Professor Brown - and we may think of some others. In Paris the President of the Academy of Medicine and the Dean of the Medical Faculty and the President of the French Society of the History of Medicine.

Good-bye! I hope you will have a very comfortable journey. It has been so nice to see you. Do let me hear how everything progresses. I suppose your address is Hamardan.
