There are one or two questions:- From whom would we get the authority to undertake the repairs? Would you, Nelligan, and a few others form a local committee? If so, please send the names. I am writing to Nelligan. I suppose he, as doctor to the Legation, should be Secretary. Would it be possible to have it done under the auspices of the Regent or the Shah? And, lastly, would you confer with Nelligan as to the names of men in Persia who should go on the General Committee?
