EXCERPTS FROM DR. CROSKEY'S ACCOUNT.

"From 1887 to 1889 he was one of the attending physicians of the Philadelphia Orthopaedia Hospital and the Infirmary for Nervous Diseases. During this period the writer, an assistant of Dr. H. Ernest Goodman, made the acquaintance of Dr. Osler. This acquaintance proved to be the commencement of a highly valued and interesting friendship, which continued until interrupted by death. The attached letter written shortly before his death refers to his connection with the Philadelphia Hospital, where he was a member of the medical staff from 1885 to 1889. The reproduction of a copy of an autopsy performed by Dr. Osler at the Philadelphia Hospital shows his scrupulous exactness."
