If you have had anything like the heat we have had I fear you have been quite unfitted for work--the few hours you were with us were very pleasant, but you looked as if you needed a long rest, I'm quite sure you are careless about your personal requirements in the way of generous diet and this extra hot weather you need keep up the supplies to make up for the waste.

Have you had a letter from Chattie? She was going to write asking you to be there next Sunday instead of coming on to Toronto if the weather cools off a little Father and I go up there on Friday to stay a few days the new Baby is to be baptized on Sunday and we would like to be introduced to her and see her mother.

You've heard of George being expected there was a tel. today to say he had arrived in New York--no welcome guest to the Islanders. I am sorry for both parties and cannot see how they are going to straighten things by his coming out.
