DEAR DOCTOR :

The undersigned, a committee representing the three undergraduate classes, the Hospital Staff, and the Faculty of the Medical Department of the University, desire to take some fitting action in the celebration of the fiftieth anniversary of Prof. D. HAYES AGNEW'S graduation from this department, and ask the co-operation of the alumni. It is proposed to have a gathering which shall be impressive, not only by the distinction of the participants, but by force of numbers, and which shall thus clearly indicate the wide-spread esteem and regard in which Dr. Agnew is held. The Chapel of the University is available for this purpose, and a supper will be served in the college building. A handsomely-bound volume of the autographs of those taking part will be given to Dr. Agnew, together with some other souvenir of the occasion. The committee would be glad to receive your subscription and to know that you will certainly be present. The date fixed upon is Tuesday, April 24, 1888.

This celebration will not conflict with the dinner which has been tendered to Dr. Agnew, but which, of course, can be participated in by but a comparatively limited number.
