It will be a sad blow to you & Marian and I am sorrowful to think of you in your grief. I wish now that I had come up on Tuesday night tho. I could not have done anything. It was evidently severe meningitis at the base of the brain. I am sorry that the funeral is so soon. I should have come up had it been delayed until Saturday but I could not reach on time leaving by tonight Poor old Gwyn & the boys will feel it badly & Percy too, & poor May. I have written to her. I suppose she has come down for the funeral. CUS417/84.19
