March 22, 1900.

My dear Osler,

It is all right about the registration. Liveing found that you had previously taken the L.R.C.P. with surgery in getting you pleaced on the Medical Register.

I am interviewing the Curators one by one and your friends in London are very busy on your behalf. Some of the most influential are writing me letters which I can put in as testimonials if I think fit when I have seen what documents you are yourself going to send in. You will have got my cable yesterday to tell you it is necessary to send in 8 copies of everything. The secretary of the curators is a lawyer and a stickler for the letter of the law. He has refused to send in the applications of some of the candidates until their testimonials also came in.
