I have got Gibson at work on the heart stuff and have sent word to Leas that it will be ready September 1st. I am pegging away at the visceral syphilis and hope to send it before long. I shall not touch the cerebral, as I think that would be very much better dealt with in connection with the nervous system. I have written to Lord and to Babcock about their articles. The question is whether it could not come in a separate section with tabes and general paralysis. I suppose young Henry will give his remarkable group of cases of which there have been at least three or four at the hospital of fatal vomiting. I hope you have got some good memoranda about it.
