I hope to meet you perhaps in Washington. In any case, I shall be in Montreal about the 12th of June and hope to have the best part of a week with you. I am anxious to see the new buildings, and all the changes in two years. You will be sorry to hear that Mills has not been doing well, bladder infected. I saw him last Wednesday just y before sailing - he was better - no fever but the operation was, I fear, not very successful. He looks well and has borne the sufferings most heroically.
