- Sat. Sept 7. Arrived Exf. Sir William met us - drove up St. Giles past
Balliol and St. John's. Lady Cesler very kind. Rereve quite a big
fellow. Lovely garden & house. Papa splendid
- Sun. Sept 8. Sir William makes good report of Papa. He showed me where
to look up about skull and cross bones [I was interested in
the symbol on poison bottles and still (1923) am.]
When I went up to bed I found a huge old *matina*
medica [?] under my pillow - put there by Sir Wm.
as I had told him of my distaste for therapeutics!
- Mon. Sept 9. Sir Wm. had to be away for the day.
- Tues. Sept 10. Sir William took me to Frielford to play golf - had flag. Back
for lunch. Dr. Klebs (son of old man) for dinner - an
interesting German - is working on inoculation (early experiments)
Sir William showed me Fuller's Worthies this evening. How
well W. O. keeps notes!
- Wed. Sept 11. To London for the day with Mamma. Sir Wm. very humorous
this evening.
- Thurs. Sept 12. Golf with Sir William and Rereve at Frielford Heath.
Met Sir Wm. at the Clarendon Buildings at 7 pm & he
showed me the Bodleian Library; went into the Sheldonian
Theatre (his seat on the left); then to Radcliffe Camera and
two stacks below grass plots outside - wonderful! Then to
the Museum & could not get ~~in~~ ⁱⁿ ~~into~~ ^{to} pathological building & met
Dr. Gibson & to physiolog labs. Home by park. Sir Wm. at dinner
talked of where his books are to go after his death - catalogue
etc.

Friday, Sept. 13. Left Oxford for Scotland; Sir Wm. saw us off at the station.

Tues. Oct. 12. [London, Mosley's Hotel] Sir Wm. Gosler came about 3.15 - set in Papa's room. He does cheer him. But he is afraid Papa cannot be made to forget himself. He went on up to see Sir Wm. Gowers.

Wed. Oct. 13. Sir Wm. saw us off at Waterloo at 9.15.
