Dear Sir William,

I enclose letter from Herringham for your information. Kindly return it when next you write.

It will evidently not be easy to alter the foreign title of our discussions. The heart one is the only one that is not satisfactory. The revised German is " Die Pathologie der Hertzschwäche".— the revised French, "La pathologie de l'asystolie". Do you think these may stand or shall we try to get them altered to, " Der Wesen der Hertzschwäche " and " Les formes différentes de l'asystolie " *de-ue*

In any case I do not think the English title should remain as at present, " The pathology of heart failure ".

The one we adopted yesterday is much more suitable, " On the different modes of heart failure". If you approve I will ask Herringham to substitute it, if still possible
