Dear Mr. Hadley:

I have just written Mr. Stokes asking him to try to raise some money for the Professors from Louvain who have taken refuge in England - Many are coming to Oxford - and are being taken into private families - but where there are families of five children it is difficult. Incomes here are reduced & undergraduates are not returning. At Magdalen only 47 coming - Christ Church about 100 - Keble 70 - *Osier* 80 - so you see what it means. About 350 lodging houses vacant. We hope to board some of these people and help them until they can get on their feet & find their firends - I am sure the University sympathy will be great and some may like to feel certain the money will be properly used. If you will help at Yale it will be a great assistance. I have asked Mr. Stokes to send anything to my banker in Boston. With kindest wishes I am
