Dear Malloch,

This will be a sad blow to you. Poor George! He had a fine career before him and it is too hard to think he should have been cut off in this tragic way. We have been thinking much of you in this sorrow.

All here are working. The spirit of the country is splendid. It is a hard toll of young lives. We have had several of our young Oxford friends killed. Revere enters the training Corps on the 1st and will apply for a commission as soon as he is fit. The action of Canada is splendid. I am very busy - in Town three days a week. We are getting a Canadian Contingent Hospital organized. I shall look after any medical cases and Armoured the surgical.
