No, of course I could not come out with all this trouble going on here. We are very busy - Lady Osler up to her eyes in work. I am knocking about the hospitals and camps. Revere has joined the Officers Training Corps here, and, when fit, will apply for a commission. The country is in very good form; nearly 700,000 recruits, and they hope to have 1,000,000 by January 1st. They will take some time to train, but, so long as England holds the seas, there is no hurry.

Send me a photograph of the hospital when it is ready, and an account of the opening.
