So glad to have your cable, and I wrote at once to Perley to ask if it had been officially presented through the Canadian Government Agency to the War Office, as I should like to know this before writing and seeing Keogh personally. It is a splendid offer, which they should be glad to accept. At present there may be a difficulty in just settling the locality, as the outcome in North West France and Belgium is still a bit uncertain.

Fortunately, for the past ten days the fighting has been slack and fewer wounded have been sent across.

I will cable you at once if there is anything definite.
