Bibliog. Soc. and met W.O. there. Paper on Lyons. Arrived Ox. 7130 - saw damage by fire to the dining-room - a narrow shave.

Apparently, aside from the plaque, there were few things of value destroyed, certainly none of the books. I find in the back of one of the MS volumes Liber D. Grimani Cardinalis S. Marci. the following not note:- "This MS has come back from Maltby with the old binding repaired. I left it with another in the dining-room, and both were badly scorched in the fire Nov. 1915 - the only two of value damaged. The old parchment covers were curled and baked". W.O.
