Dear Miss Loring

xxx Grace wrote about the funeral, which was really most impressive. I had never before seen a military funeral given to a nurse. I am sorry clip-pings are forbidden, but I am keeping a paper. I am sending a notice to the J. Hopkins Hospital Nurses Journal. She was a fine character & I can never forget the devoted service she gave us in those early days in Baltimore. I am so glad you sent me word about her as I fear she would not have let me know. ~~xxx I do not like to charge you fees for any service I may have rendered to an old friend; but if you care to send \$100 (= \$500 (the equivalent for the fee rate for two visits) to the Dominion Bank, Toronto, to my account, I will see that it is spent in war purposes. xx~~
