I have sent word at once to Ernest at No 4 General, & will see him if he is still there but your letter was dated May 2nd: We are getting letters thro. now in about 2 weeks - as a rule. I will let you know about E. We had Revere home for ten days - his first leave since Oct. Such a big, hardened fellow, He had not slept in a bed for seven months. He has been all thro. this Arras fighting. For tunately he is with such nice fellows in the R.F.A. It keeps us anxious. I have just lost another nephew. I hope the Robertson (of Montreal) whose death I see is not your nephew.
