Fortunately Harvey Cushing was at the Cas. clearing Station to which he was taken & he & Crile did everything possible. It is a terrible blow for us but we shall try to bear it bravely.

We have not yet seen Ernest. Do tell him to come to us when he gets leave. Love to you all
