From Dr. Malloch's Journal Saturday, Jan. 19, 1918.

Arrived Oxford. Found Sir Wm. in bed here with a cold - looks pretty well. At work at books as usual. Has just got a fine Averrees, and he studies it through the Fr. works (Renan) on him - Arabic studies in Algiers; and Jas. Gregory's (Prof. of Med. Edinb. 1741 - 62 (?)) book on quarrel with John Bell. Says there is an increase in Addison's disease in the war. Asks if we have had influenzal broncho-pneumonia which has gone on to bronchiectasis etc. (Bogg's papers).
