From Dr. Malloch's Journal. Sunday, Feb. 9, 1919.

Cases at the Radcliffe. W.O. got out more packets. I saw offering him position at Phila. also his unpublished address when he first got to Pennsylvania. Outline of book on diagnosis which he had hoped to write. Notice of book of 'Oslerisms'. Two house physicians wished to do this, but W.O. did not consent to write the introduction, and squashed the whole thing when he saw the MS. Saw Ordino's flowery letter to W.O. on his becoming Regius Prof. Letter from Papa about the Edinb. Chair.
