Your tablet comes from the temple library of Assur the old capital of Assyria, and is not from Ninevah itself. The period is that of Sardanapelus who founded the great library at Ninevah, or perhaps a bit earlier being written most likely under Senecherits grandfather of Sardanapelus. These kings patronized schools of medicine in the old capitol as well as at Ninevah. This is the first medical tablet from the library of Assur and was beyond doubt plundered from the German excavations which were captured by our army. reign of sargoy ging of assyria, 721 706 B.C. or perhaps to the reign
