Dear Col Strong

I was sorry to send that wire but I could not do otherwise. There is no use his going off on that jaunt. It would be tremendously interesting but this is no time for him to be racketing about.

We had kund a welfare lady here today for luncheon "Miss Babbit" She talked more than fifteen minutes - and told us all her plans for the Conference - I hope we shall see Dr. Welch on his way home. I did not receive your letter inclosing Dr. Rellys. It must have gone astray -
