(A.C. Klebs) Yours of the 12th here today [from N.Y.], with your greetings - and also with the sad news of Jacobi's death. We had not heard yet, and it is not long - a week or two, since I had such a nice letter from him. What an innings he has had! & he was a dear lovable man. We had a busy birthday. No wonder they would not take your mystic cable [Latin birthday greeting]! Allbutts presentation of the volumes was a treat to see - he is wonderful at 83 - & so keen & alert in mind & body. I am keeping well & hope now to get out of a good many things and devote more time to my library. I wish you could see the way it has grown, & I have now the catalogue revision nearly complete. I am glad you are going to your beloved Switzerland.....Should you come thro England call up 206 at once & come as soon as you can. We shall be in Jersey from Aug.1st to Sept.15th.
